After-school Madrassa for Islamic & Qur'an Studies, 2018

Dear parents,

It gives us great pleasure to announce that this week we will commence the afternoon madrassa classes for our selected students in 2018. **Australian International Islamic College** is fully acknowledged for opening this madrassa for the following two streams of Islamic Studies project. Parents are invited to enrol their children in any of these streams. There is a marginal fee of **\$100 per term** involved.

1. **Alim pathway** is an intense study for preparing future Ulama or scholars of Islam. Enrolment in this study is restricted to those students from Year 5 to 10 who are advanced in their Islamic and Arabic studies. Discipline is also a requirement.
2. **Standard Madrassah** is an ordinary madrassa setting and is for those children who want to improve their Qur'an reading skills.

The classes will be conducted on every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3:30 to 5:00.
