COVID-19- Updated Advice and Work from Home

I contact you today, as the Principal of the Australian International Islamic College, to relay to you some pertinent information regarding the evolving COVID-19 pandemic.

The Prime Minister has just announced that schools will remain open until the end of the school term. We are firmly committed to the safety and welfare of our students, and of our staff. We have already proactively implemented a number of measures to limit student contact, to increase sanitation and to reduce the chance of a contagion spread.

AllC is remaining open; however, **from Tuesday 24 March, I would ask children be kept at home if parents are able to do so.** We have provided ample learning enhancement material for students to work from home, and make an assurance that we will continue to do so. Our secondary students have access to digital platforms for textbooks and online learning. Our teachers have worked tirelessly to finish, or modify assessment. Any student in the Secondary College who has outstanding assessment should contact their teacher for clarity. The safest place for everyone at this time, is at home.

Let me be clear by reiterating that AllC has **no confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19.** However, we are making this request, for parents to keep their children at home if they can, to further increase the safety measures we are wrapping around our community.

Please heed the advice of the Department of Health. Stay at home as much as you can. Do not go out if you, or your children are unwell. Please, be kind and look out for one another, and those who are most vulnerable in our community.
