On Tuesday 31 August 2021 we became aware of a College family who attended the Carrara campus and who may have recently returned from interstate. This matter is currently under review by the Authorities.

As this matter is currently under review, it is not appropriate to comment further, save as to say that there has been no positive COVID-19 test on the College grounds and that the school closure is a precautionary measure only.

The Gold Coast department of Health advised a precautionary closure of the campus on Thursday 2nd September whilst they conduct a risk assessment, which we enacted immediately.

The safety and wellbeing of our students and staff is always of paramount importance to us. As such we will continue to work very closely with Queensland Health, and to ensure that all necessary health advice is adhered to.

Whilst the school is currently closed, we continue to provide remote learning to our students, as well as wellbeing support to our whole College

As a community school we are banding together to support all of our families during this incredibly difficult time. We have consistently been enforcing and encouraging all health directives, in school and out in the community to ensure that we can keep our community safe.

Again, we want to reiterate that we are working closely with Queensland Health and following all directives for the safety and welfare of our students, staff and for the broader community.
