

Orientation program for new homestay host families



The Australian International Islamic College (AIIC) provides an orientation program for new host families to make them aware of their roles and responsibilities. This program is compulsory and outlines the aims of the homestay program and provides practical advice and information to help fulfil their roles and responsibilities.

The families will be provided the following information during the orientation:

- Homestay family code of conduct
- Information on cultural sensitivity including specific cultural and religious requirements
- Homestay rules for students
- Contact details of school and officer in-charge for AIIC's homestay program
- Home stay insurance

The host families will be provided the opportunity to raise any queries and concerns related to the program. The potential hosts also complete the application forms and Blue Card application form (if they already do not have it).

The officer will create a profile for each family that will include the photos of their homes and student rooms. Written permission will be requested from the hosts to distribute the pictures to prospective students.
