### BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) Program 2025

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

You may already be aware that the College successfully introduced the BYOD program for Years 7–12 in 2020, and its success led to its extension to Year 5 and 6 students in 2021. For 2025, your child, entering Year 5, will also be required to bring a device to school for their learning.

Together with our IT Department, we have outlined below AIIC's minimum recommended specifications for a device.

**Note: Chromebooks, iPads, and tablets are not allowed as they are NOT compatible with the AIIC BYOD Program.**

These are the specifications of AIIC BYOD Laptops that the students will need:
