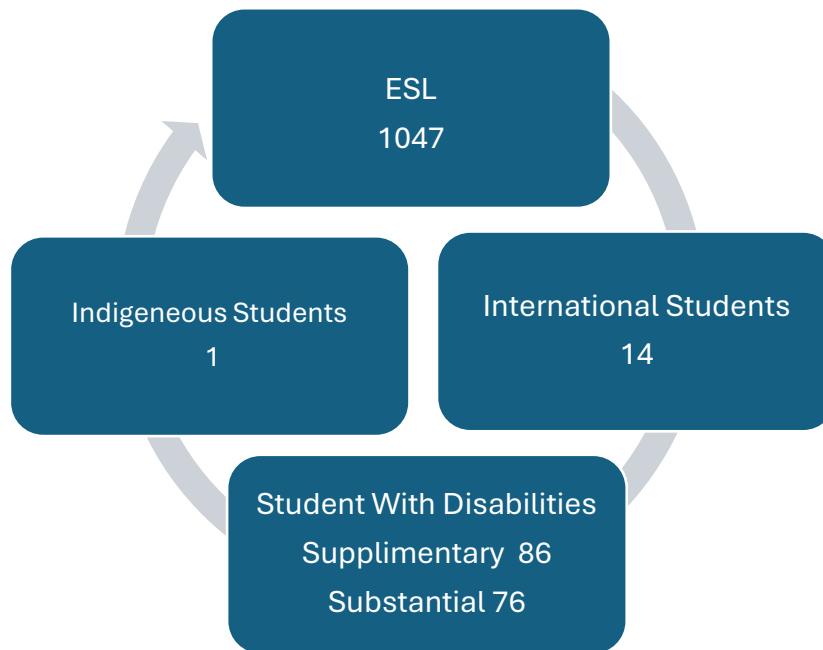

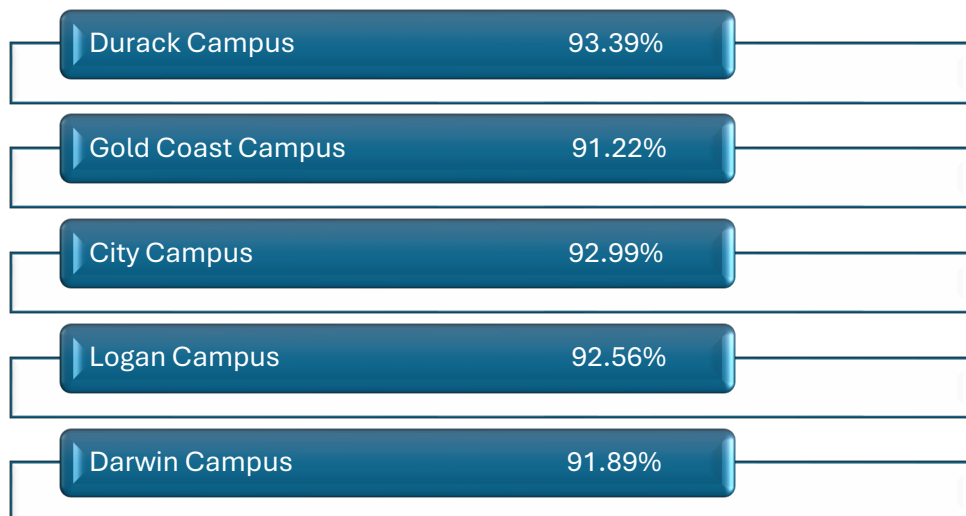

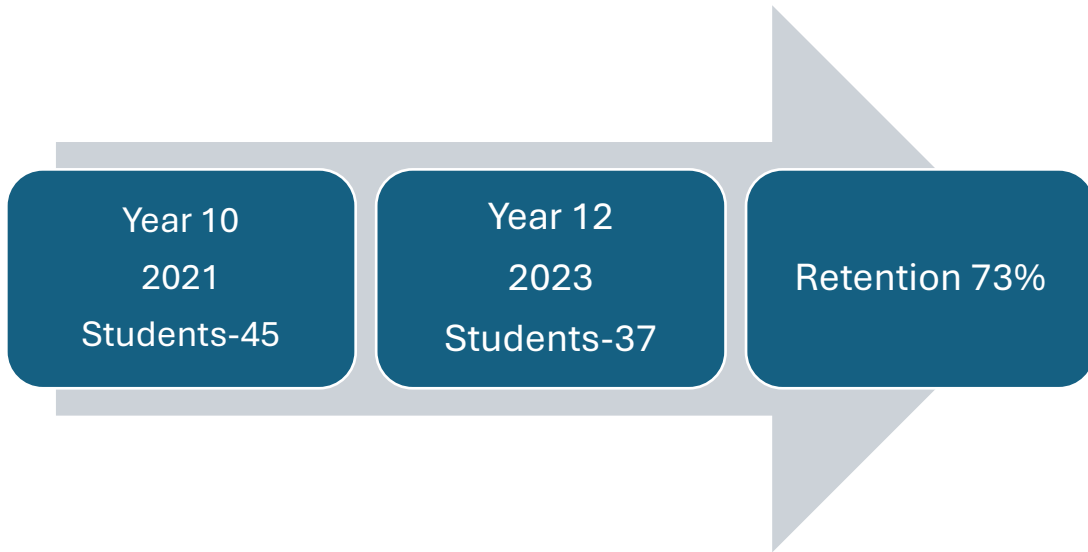


Student Attendance

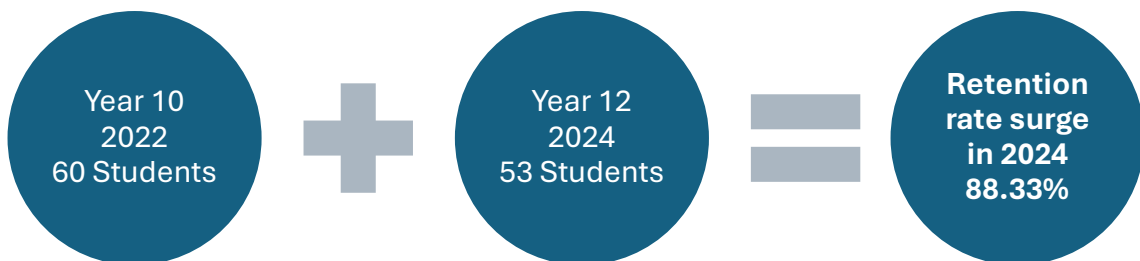


Student Retention Rate – Year 10 to 12

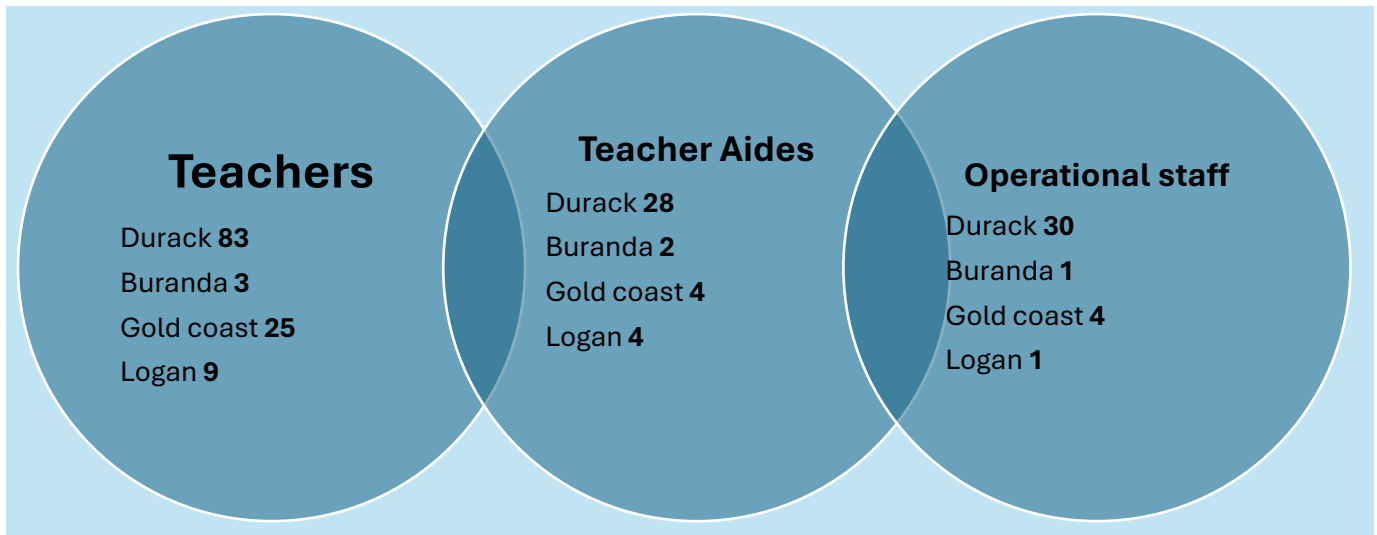
