YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE SAFE

Every child has a right to feel safe; at home, at school and when they are out in the community. No one has the right to make you feel unsafe. This means that they cannot abuse you, physically or sexually; they cannot harass or intimidate you, and the adults who are taking care of you cannot neglect you or knowingly put you in harms way.

Remember, a safe adult will never ask you to keep a secret that makes you feel uncomfortable, and they won't threaten you to keep you silent.
